



Will Your Property Require Flood Insurance?

A recent study has determined that the levee along the Ventura River no longer meets FEMA's standards. As a result, FEMA may place your property into a mapped floodplain. This may result in the need to purchase flood insurance and require new construction to meet floodplain development standards. Visit www.vcwatershed.org/levee for additional information.
